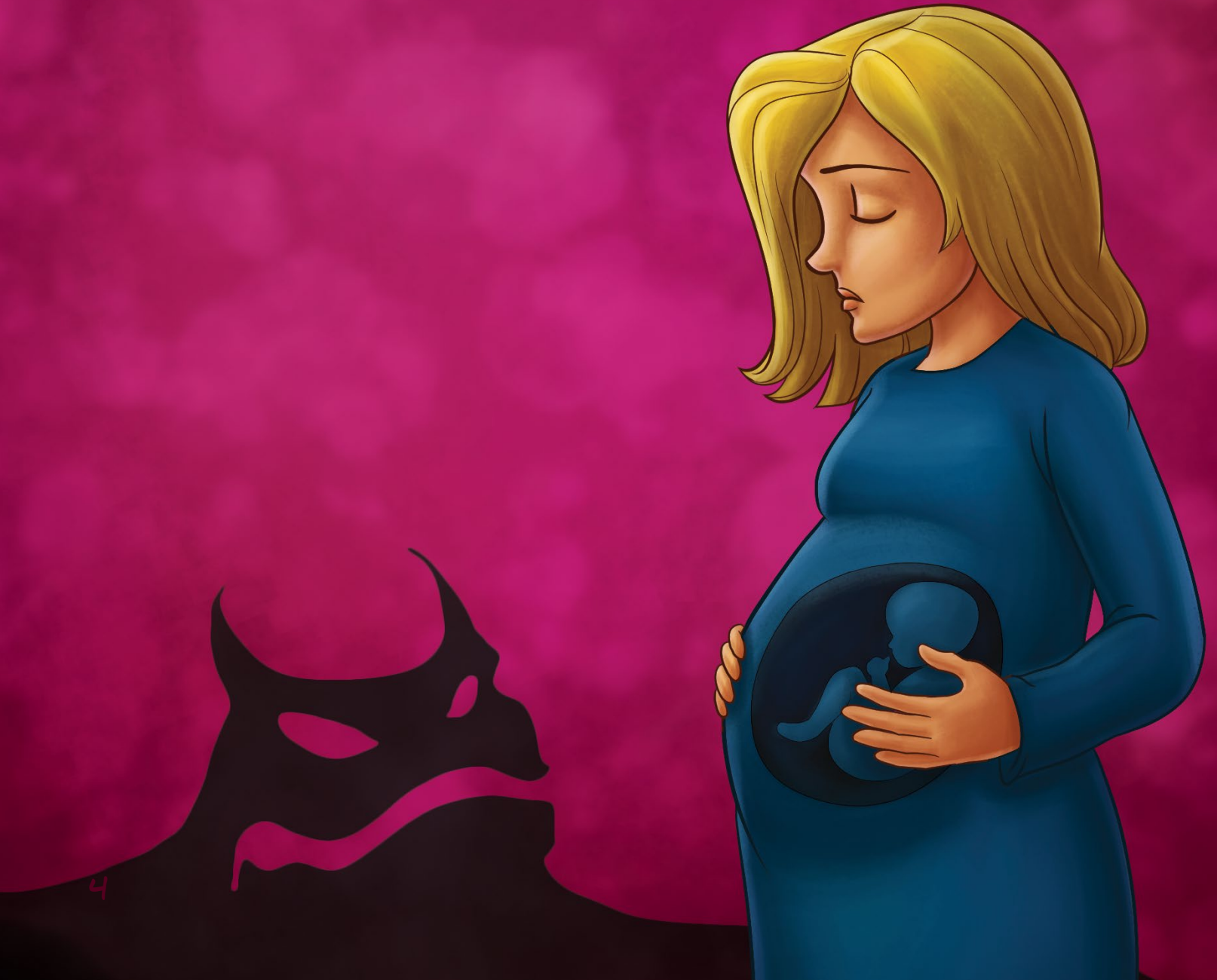
Once upon a time

God never makes mistakes!"

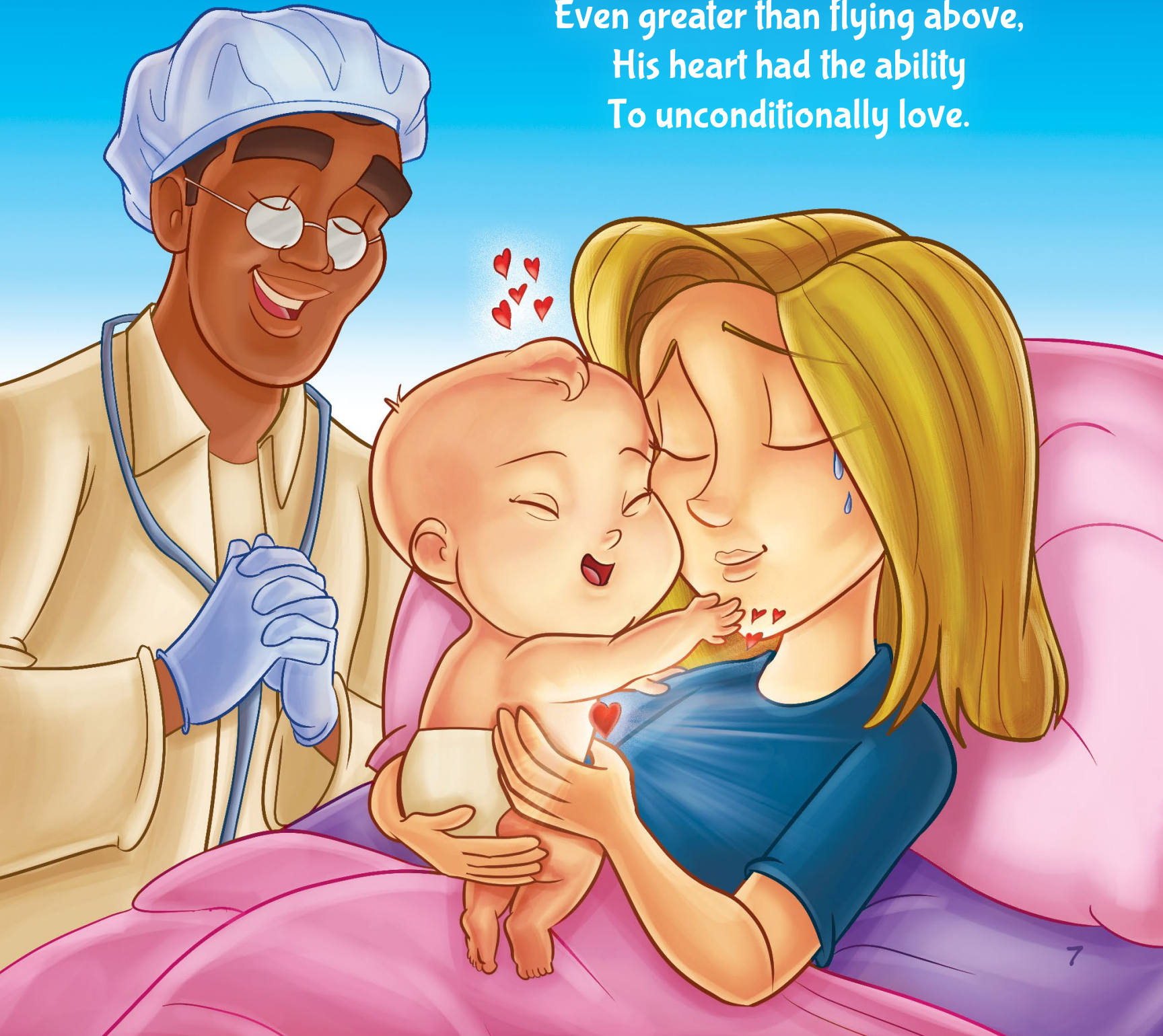


From the start, everyone knew

That filled his mom with joy.

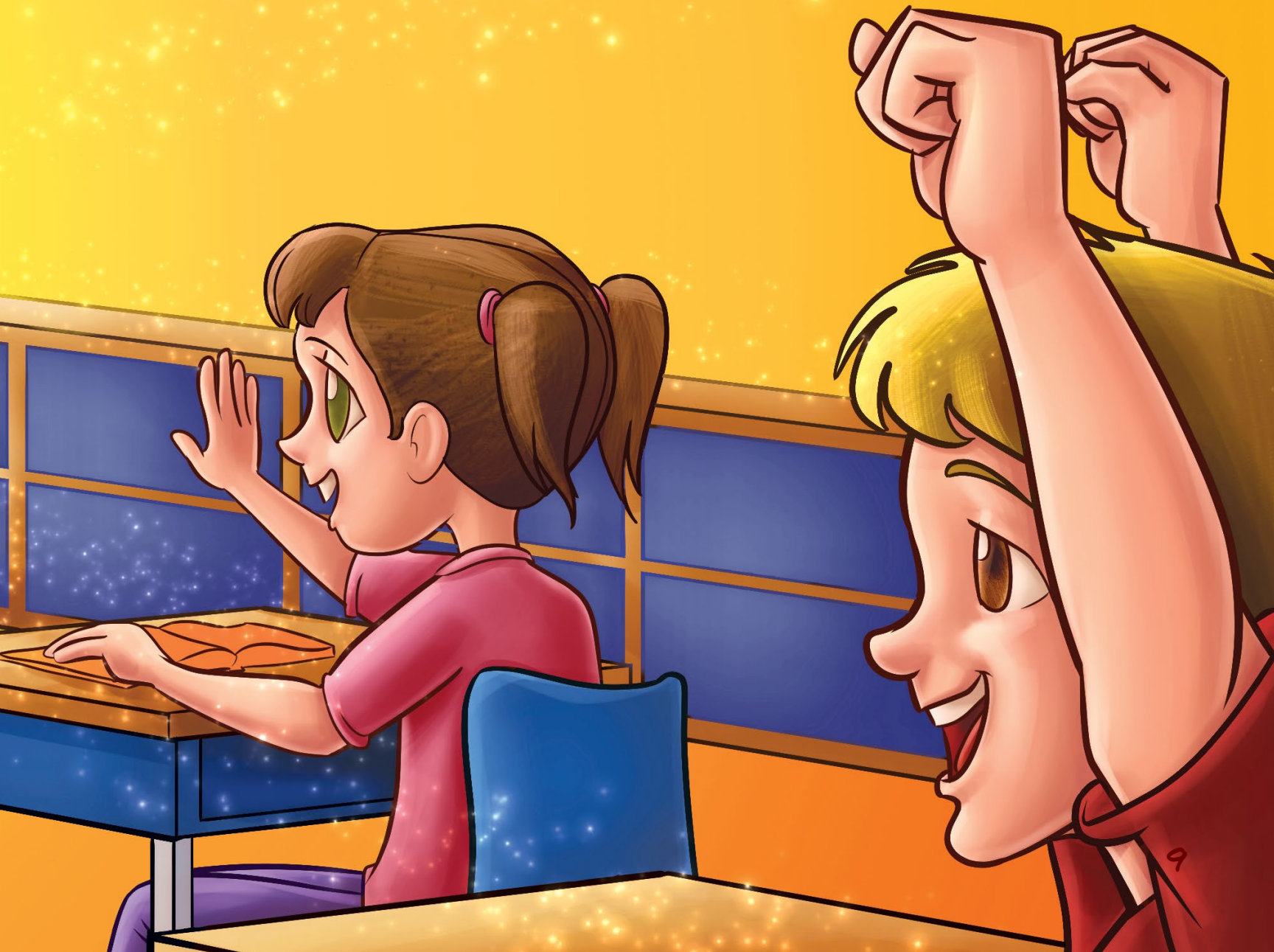


Super J was born with a power

Or pretending to have wings.**



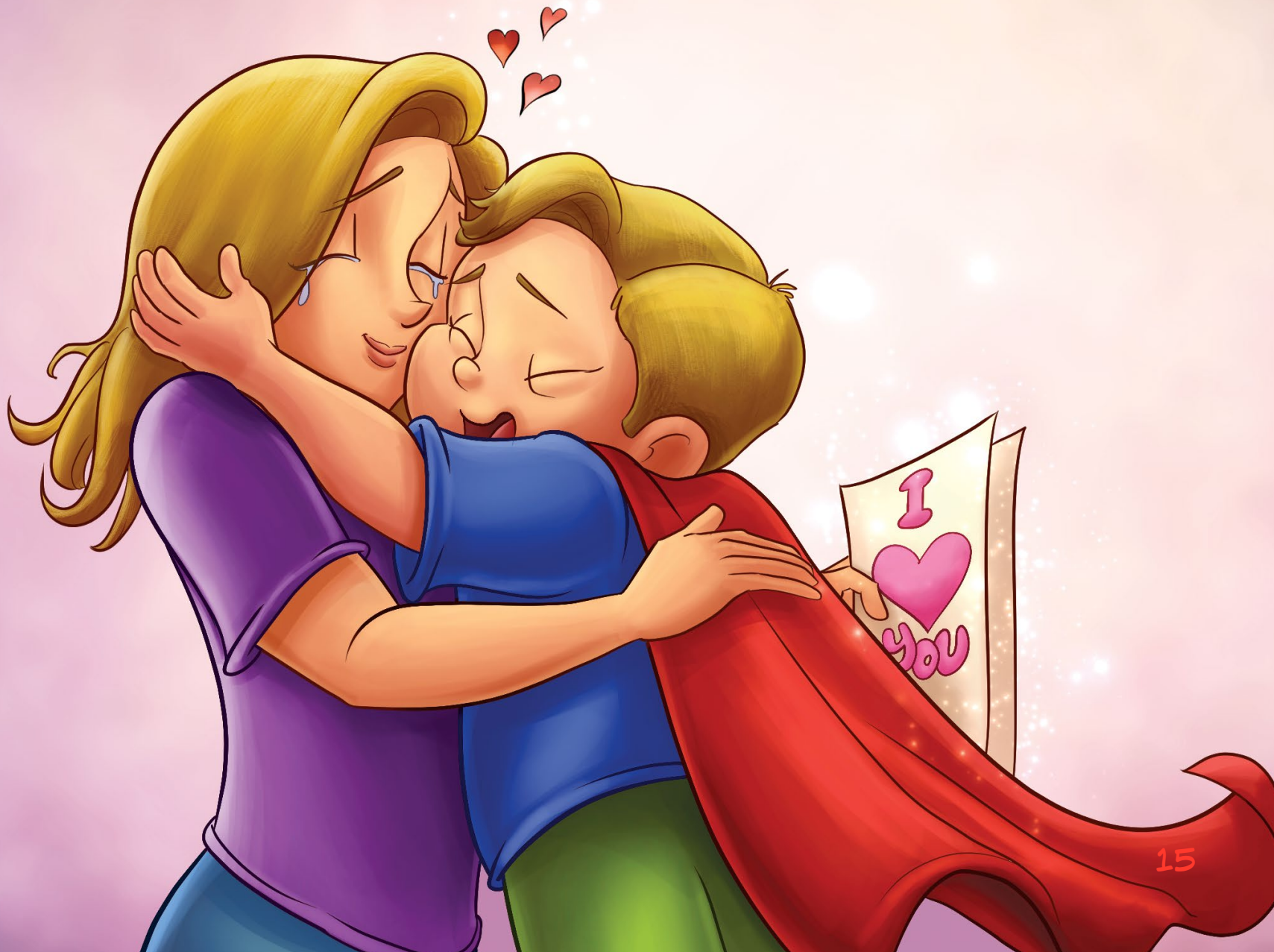
He shows us to be thankful

Are glad when he is near.

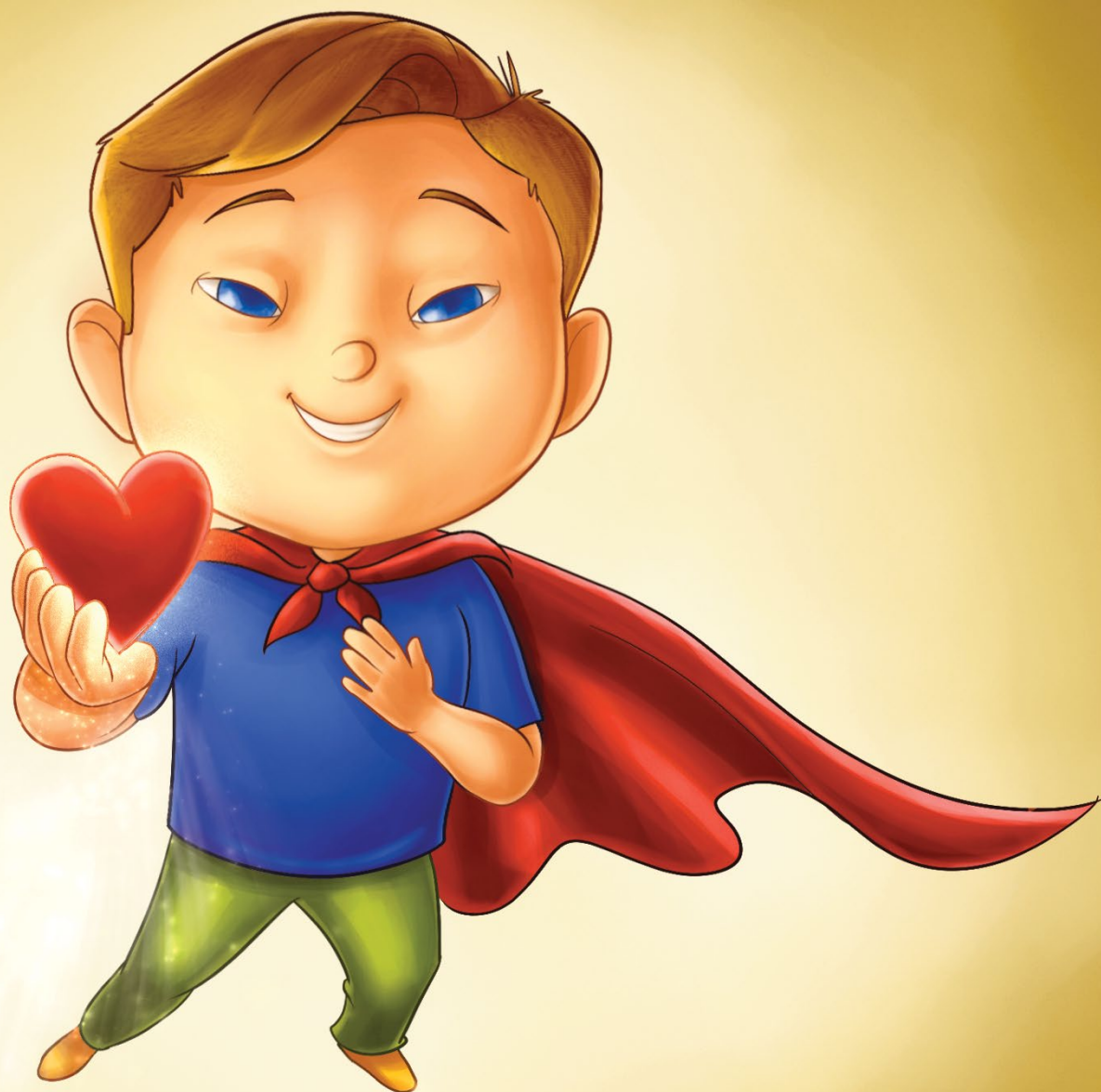


Super J mends hearts

What's most important to know.

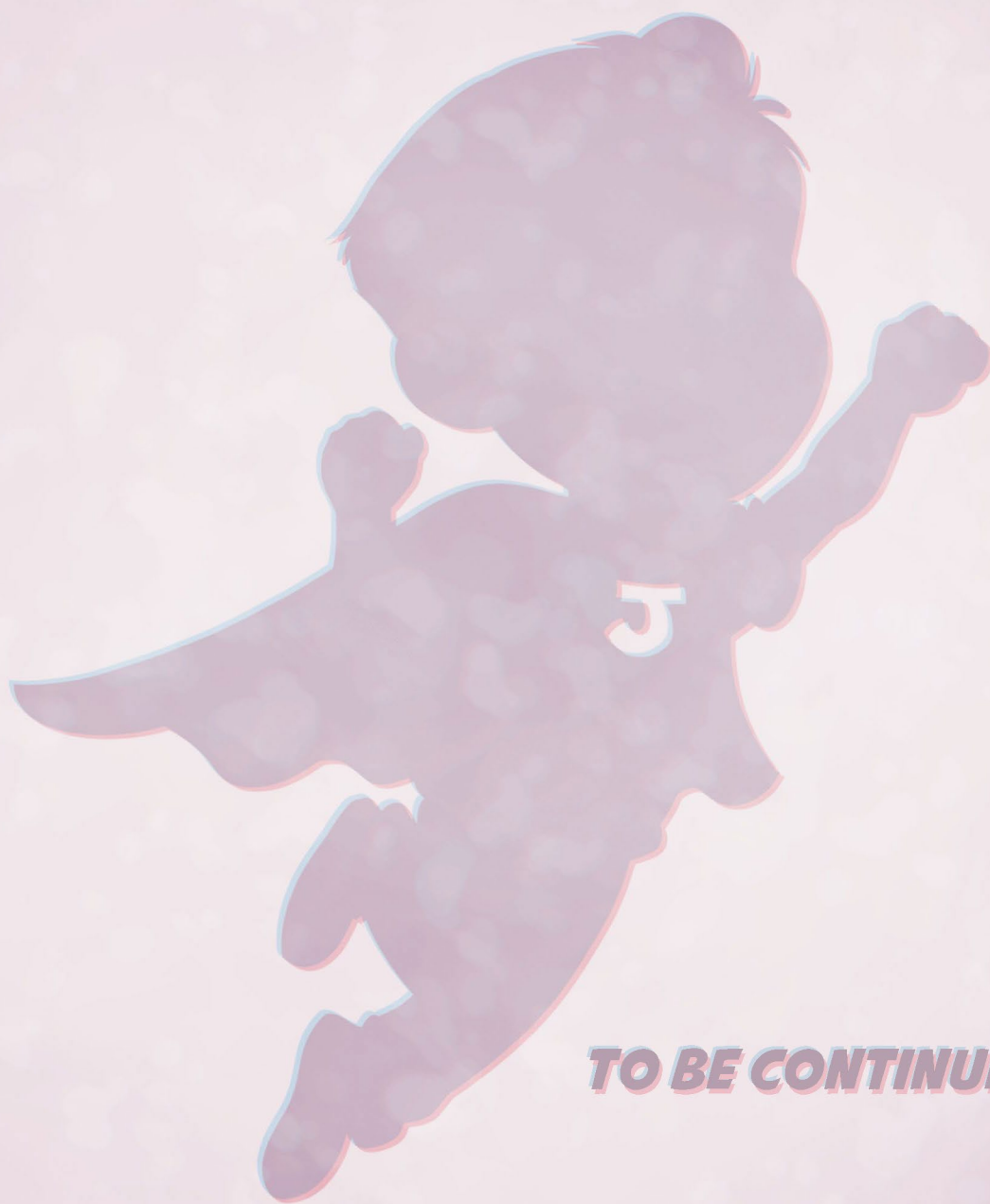




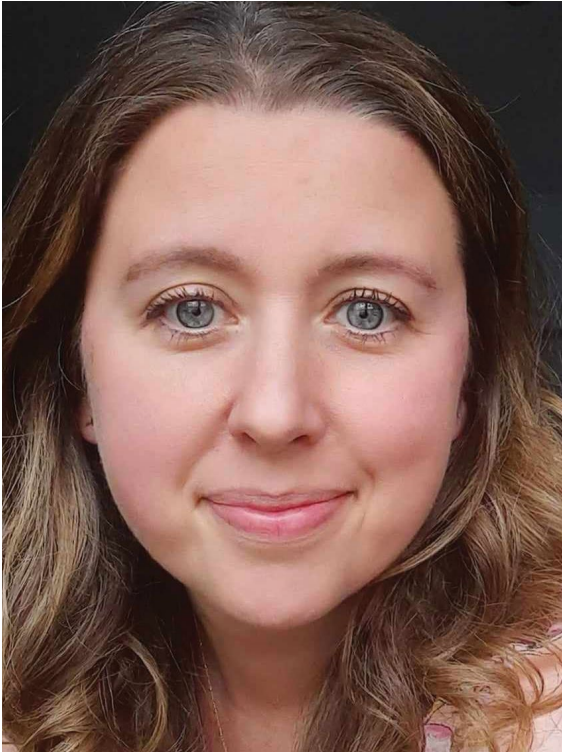
Love should not be locked inside,
